2. PROCEDURE

- Starting Jan 2023 we will do GED

- We will do our first prelims end of 3rd term if all guidelines are followed, Finals will be done 4th term subject to students progress and goals met
- We want to encourage students to do as many accredited course in addition to their matric – we will advise if we have found any
- Assistance will be provided through out 2023 for application of 2024
- We can always take longer to do GED this individual to the student and their ability
- All student require a smart ID card for writing exams
- All require a chipped debit card (not capitec) open to international purchases

3. SCORES

- To write half test ALL SUBJECT require a score of 160
- To pass half test – 145 score is required per subject
- To write finals ALL SUBJECT require a score of 200
- To pass finals – 145 score is required per subject

4. EXAMS

- We are able to write 3 times (payable every time) and then we have a wait for 60 days before a final attempt can be made for finals
- We can write half tests in a similar fashion but this must be completed prior to writing finals
- Relevant scores apply we will provide many websites and youTube links to be saved the key to success is practise test, practise test and practise test....They always have this to do

Boston is accepting GED Graduates for Degrees

Ruan Venter, the Registrar at Boston City Campus announced in the webinar yesterday that Boston City Campus will be accepting GED® graduates for Degree studies in 2022. To meet the Degree admission criteria, GED applicants will need to achieve a score of 155 or more in their RLA test and a combined score of 625+ for all four assessments. This excludes the Bachelor's in Accounting.

Boston City Campus is committed to helping GED students furthering their studies and will therefore help GED students with their USAF exemption applications should they meet the Degree admission score requirements. Please do not apply directly to USAF yourself, you must apply to USAF through Boston City Campus.

Any student who does not achieve the required Degree admission scores, can register for a Higher Certificate at Boston City Campus, and then apply for a Degree program. To meet the Higher Certificate admission criteria, a student must achieve their GED Diploma. Should a student complete a Higher Certificate at Boston City Campus and then progress onto a Degree program, up to 50% of your credits can potentially be transferred to your Degree.

Boston City Campus does not require GED students to apply to SAQA for a Certificate of Evaluation for admission into a Higher Certificate, as they recognise the GED and understand its equivalency.
